

Queen Anne's Lace – Wild Carrot Daucus carota

4 ounces scoured wool 8-10 ounces of plant tops and flowers Stainless steel stockpot 1 ½ tsp alum* (aluminum sulphate)* 1 ½ tsp cream of tartar

Presoak wool in warm tap water.

Place plant tops in pot, cover with water, simmer for 30-60 minutes.

Remove plants from dye pot.

Dissolve alum & cream of tartar in hot water and stir into dye liquid.

Stir evenly until dissolved in dye bath.

Add wool, heat on medium heat (160-180·F) for 1 hour.

Remove wool from dye pot, rinse in warm water until liquid runs clear.

Hang in shade to dry.

<u>Safety Tips:</u> Never use everyday kitchen equipment. Keep dye pots and equipment separate. Wear heat resistant gloves, especially when handling mordants*. Dye outdoors or in well ventilated area.
